This is a synopsis of the official minutes for the General Council Business Meeting held June 13, 2002.

Steve Kunkel presented the checks from the Tootsie Roll drive before the meeting. Representatives from Possibilities, and Hiawatha Homes joined us to receive their monies.

Doug Butler, director of Hiawatha Homes spoke about his group. They have been doing a major reorganization trying to plan for and remodel their Valkyrie Home that used to be a 43-bed facility. Hopefully in September it will be transformed into a smaller more home like facility with 2 homes, side by side, each with room for 5 people. These homes are for the mentally handicapped. A third of the space will be used for administration. A new home is also being built in Ridgeview. Doug offered space to have one of our meetings. The money will be used to furnish the houses.

John Flanders from Possibilities received their check. Possibilities serves some of the same individuals, and provides transportation for their clients. They have 11 vehicles to get everybody where they need to be when they need to be there. They have a new program in collaboration with the YMCA for people who are too old for daycare, but don't want to left at home. Possibilities helps provide the staffing to support the participating 16-18yr old kids. Possibilities is always in need of help for wall repair, painting, etc.

The Deputy Grand Knight, Brad Brech, called the meeting to order at 7:56 p.m.

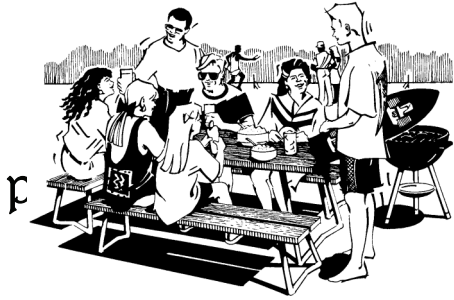
Prayers for Special Intentions and the Good of the Order

The meeting adjourned at 8:50pm.

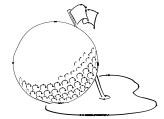
